Dear Parent / Carer,

Re: Year 11 Assessment Information for next half term for [REDACTED]

As you will be aware from Mr George's letter on the 19/03/21, Year 11 students will have further opportunities to demonstrate what they know and can do during the course of next half term. The purpose of this pack of information is to give students all the information they need to prepare fully for these opportunities, which will all take place in normal lesson times. In providing this prior to the Easter holidays, students should have ample time to begin to prepare fully and have some time to relax. Teachers will continue to use the majority of lesson time after Easter to prepare for these assessments.

Year 11 students will have two further periods of formal assessments after the Easter holidays. Each of these continues over a fortnight period. You will see that we have tried to distribute assessments sensibly across each fortnight. The timetable below shows an overview of each fortnight. The coloured squares indicate the periods where that subject may be having a formal assessment in the lesson. Please refer to the more detailed table for each subject below for the full information of when assessments will occur in specific subject areas. Each subject has provided greater detail on what topics will be included in each assessment, the types of questions in the assessment and recommendations of appropriate revision resources. If a line is greyed out on the tables below it means the subject is not using that assessment slot. Mr Park has done a video presentation explaining this information which students were shown on Tuesday 30th March. In late January we sent you mock exam grades from the December Year 11 mock exams and provided latest predicted grades based on all of the work students completed during the Autumn term. From the 4th January to 8th March Year 11 students continued working through subject content via remote learning and 'live lessons'. Many students in Year 11 engaged really well during lockdown, but some did not. It is important that both students and parents are made aware if we have concerns that students may not now be secure at the predicted grades we gave in January because of limited engagement in the Year 11 remote curriculum and / or limited engagement in face to face lessons over the last few weeks since we have returned to school. The table below shows any subjects where your son / daughter's teacher(s) feel he / she is now no longer secure at that January predicted grade. He / She should pay particular attention to their preparation for assessments in these subjects by using the subject information included below and engaging fully in all of their lessons after Easter. *If no subjects are shown in the table, then subject teachers are not worried **at this point in time** that your son / daughter is not secure at those January predicted grades.*

As well as preparing for these assessments, it will be equally important that students have the opportunities they need to relax and to mix with family and friends, as society hopefully starts to reopen a little. At this stage, I would urge parents and carers to start discussing with students how they can get the balance right between school work and other activities over Easter. As ever, if you are worried about your son or daughter in Year 11 or Year 13 then please do not hesitate to contact the relevant pastoral team who will be happy to help.
