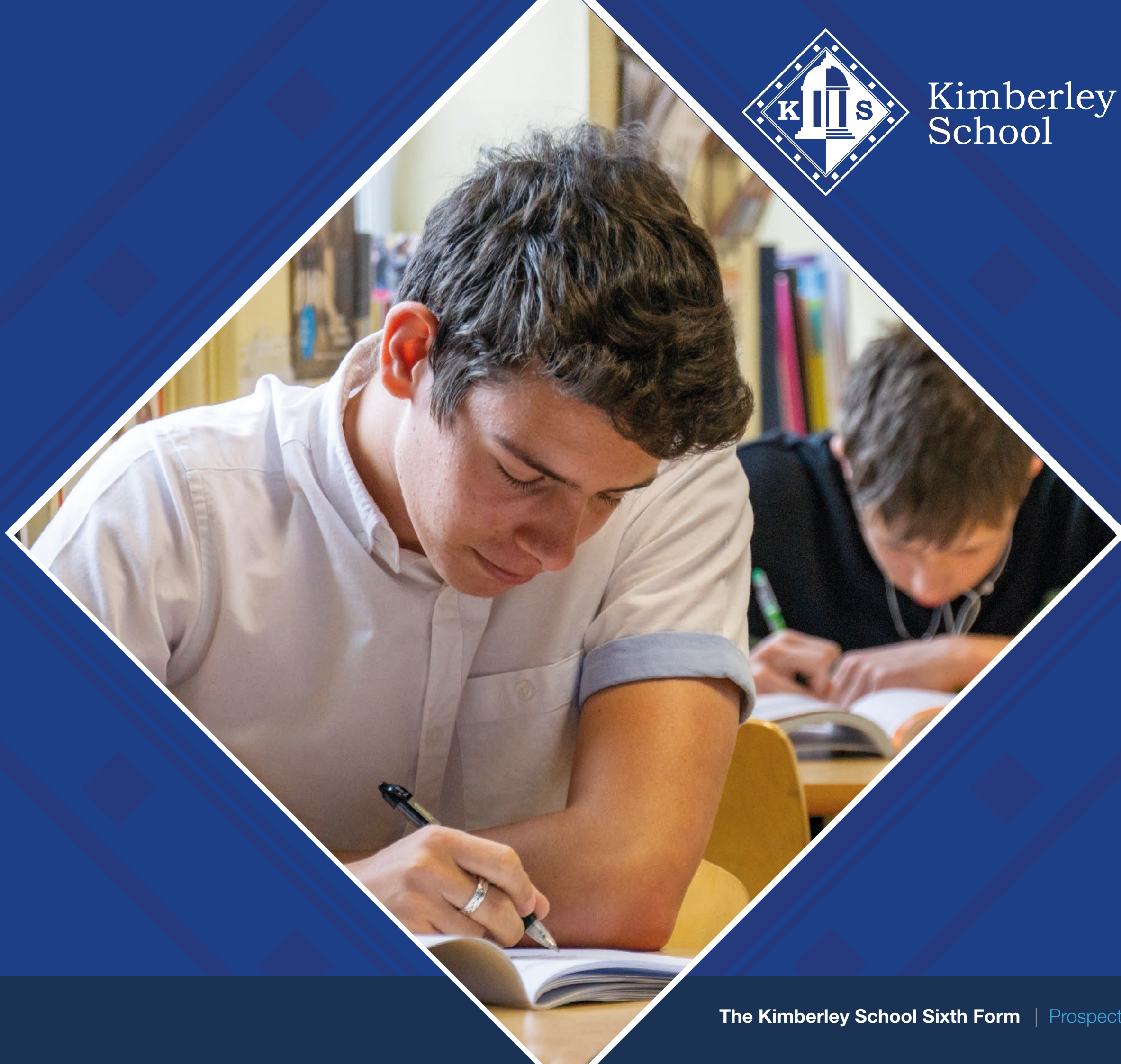

Supporting you every step of the way

The school is proud of its student support structure and each student has individual attention, in a caring environment.

Every student has regular contact with a tutor who offers support and guidance through the challenges of UCAS entry, CV writing and career pathways.

Careers

Students have access to a careers advisor as well as a tutorial programme that broadens their awareness and understanding of the range of Post-18 options.

Facilities

Sixth Form students have access to their own food outlet in the Common Room although they are entitled to have lunch off site. There are lockers in the Common Room, as well as computers and a printer. There are also computers and a quiet work room in the library for Sixth Form use.

Broadening your horizons

All students are encouraged to participate in the school and wider community as part of their enrichment.

Organising and leading events to support charitable causes provides students with some of their most rewarding and enjoyable experiences.

Enrichment

In addition to their studies, students in Year 12 are expected to choose an Enrichment activity, such as the Duke of Edinburgh Award, Cookery, Sports Leadership and the Extended Project Qualification. This is for students to enhance their applications to university and apprenticeships as well as to encourage them to sustain a healthy work/life balance.

Work Experience

In the Summer Term of Year 12, students are given a week to experience a workplace environment, which they are encouraged to choose in line with their career goals. The experience is also useful in university and apprenticeship applications.

Community Service

Students are encouraged to give back to their community by volunteering an hour of their time per fortnight. Many students choose to do this in school by supporting a younger class. Not only does this opportunity strengthen community bonds, but gives students the chance to enhance future applications further.

Independent Study

Students have a number of study periods on their timetable. This is to develop their ability to work independently and to improve their organisation, time management and research skills. There are several areas in the school where students can work quietly and independently, including the Sixth Form Common Room and the Sixth Form Quiet Room in the library
