

## **Kimberley School. Tuesday Hall 1 Pod – Factsheet for Parents and Students**

- You have been allocated a place in the **Tuesday Hall 1 Pod**. You cannot swap this for another group. Your provision starts on **Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> June**. You should **arrive at school at 9:15 am** for a 9:30 start, do not arrive early or late. Your provision will finish at 12:50 pm and will include a short, 20-minute break. Your entrance to the school site is the car entrance **on Newdigate Street** and you should follow the **signs for “Hall 1 Pod”**. Remember that remote education remains the main focus of provision this term. Face to face provision supplements this.
- Students **must not attend** if:
  - they or a member of their household is **displaying symptoms of coronavirus or has recently tested positive**
  - they have been **identified as clinically extremely vulnerable** due to pre-existing medical conditions.
- Students deemed **clinically vulnerable** (not clinically extremely vulnerable) must follow medical advice.
- **If a student lives with someone who is clinically extremely vulnerable**, then the government advice is that they can attend school if parents and school are satisfied that stringent social distancing can be adhered to and they are able to understand and follow those instructions.
- Government advice is that **students living with someone who is clinically vulnerable (but non clinically extremely vulnerable), including those who are pregnant**, can attend school.
- The [NHS website](#) defines who is clinically extremely vulnerable and who is clinically vulnerable
- Students **must bring with them**:
  - a pen, pencil, ruler and calculator. If possible they should bring the exercise books, folders and booklets they use in English, Maths and Science. A notebook may also be helpful.
  - A bottle of water (water fountains are turned off), students can bring snacks if they want to
- Students **can bring with them**:
  - A mobile phone but this should be on silent and not in view
  - Hand sanitiser, although there is plenty in school
  - Face masks, these are not compulsory but students can wear their own if they want to
  - A bike lock if they are riding their bike to school, as ever we expect them to wear a helmet
- In order to get to school:
  - Students should **avoid public transport if at all possible**. If they do use it, they must wear a face mask
  - Parents can drop students off but **they must not enter the school car park and must arrange pick up and drop off points elsewhere in Kimberley**.
- **Students do not have to wear uniform** but everything they wear should be clean and easily washable. Students should not wear revealing or inappropriate clothing or anything which promotes an offensive slogan
- **Students should be aware of these social distancing and hygiene rules** when they attend school:
  - Arrive on time for their allocated pod and use the correct entrance
  - Maintain 2m distance from all others at all times including when queuing.
  - Maintain excellent hand hygiene. Washing or sanitizing hands at every available opportunity.
  - Maintain excellent respiratory hygiene when coughing or sneezing into a tissue (catch it, bin it, kill it) or into the crook of their elbow
  - Do not share equipment
  - They can only enter the toilet at any one time and must use hand sanitiser when they return to their lesson
