



Dear Parents, Carers and Sixth Form Students

Changes to arrangements for Sixth Form Results' Day – 13th August 2020

We have been contacted by a number of students in recent weeks who are anxious about reports they are reading of an increase in the number of new positive Covid-19 cases in Nottinghamshire. In this context, some students are worried about having to come in to school to collect their results on the 13th August. A number have asked if it would be possible for us to email the results to them so that they can decide if they would like to come in to school to meet with staff once they have seen their results.

Therefore, we have decided that we will email results to Sixth Form students at 8am on Thursday 13th August. The email will be sent to each students' school email address.

Students will then be able to decide if they would like to meet with a member of staff in school. They will also be able to request a video-conference or telephone call with a member of staff if they would prefer this. The careers service will also be available for appointments. Students will be able to contact school immediately on receiving their grades, **Mrs Livings will be in touch with parents and students on the 11th August to explain the process for contacting school once you have received your results.** Students and parents should not attend school without an appointment.

Whilst there is no local lockdown in place, local Public Health officials are asking the public to avoid lots of mass gatherings indoors. They, like us, are anxious that we avoid a local lockdown and are able to open schools to all students as planned at the start of September. I am confident that by using the process described above we are able to meet this public health need and provide individual support where it is needed when students receive their exam grades.

Please don't worry - our staff will be here for you when you have received your results and we will find a way of providing whatever support you need.

Students should also be aware that Ofqual have published [a guide for students](#) setting out all of the information you need to know about your grades. This is an important read for all students. Please, also remember to keep checking the school website for information about this year's exam [results days](#) and details on what you can do if you are concerned about the grades you are awarded.
