

Our Solar System



ACROSS

- Planet named after the Roman goddess of love and beauty
- Our solar system is part of this galaxy
- Nicknamed "the red planet"
- Third largest planet in our solar system
- Now called a dwarf planet
- Covers 70 percent of the Earth's surface
- Largest planet in our solar system
- Planet closest to the sun

- Closest star to Earth
