Engagement / Impact	Pastoral care provision: Tutors have contacted tutees weekly and fed back information to the 6th Form team. The weekly Bulletin has continued and from feedback is more widely read than ever.
	Disadvantaged, , vulnerable, those struggling to engage independently and the emotionally fragile have all been receiving regular phone support from the 6th Form team
	Disadvantaged students have been provided with school laptops where necessary
	Parents of students who are a concern have been receiving regular contact via email and phone calls to enable the partnership to continue. A Parent Bulletin was sent out before May half term .
Issues	High amount of contact with subject staff about students who are a concern enabling follow up .
