These are just suggestions of the things the centre uses most, but any gift you can give will be gratefully received.

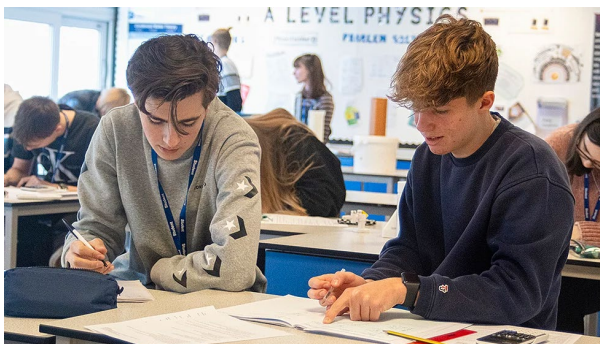

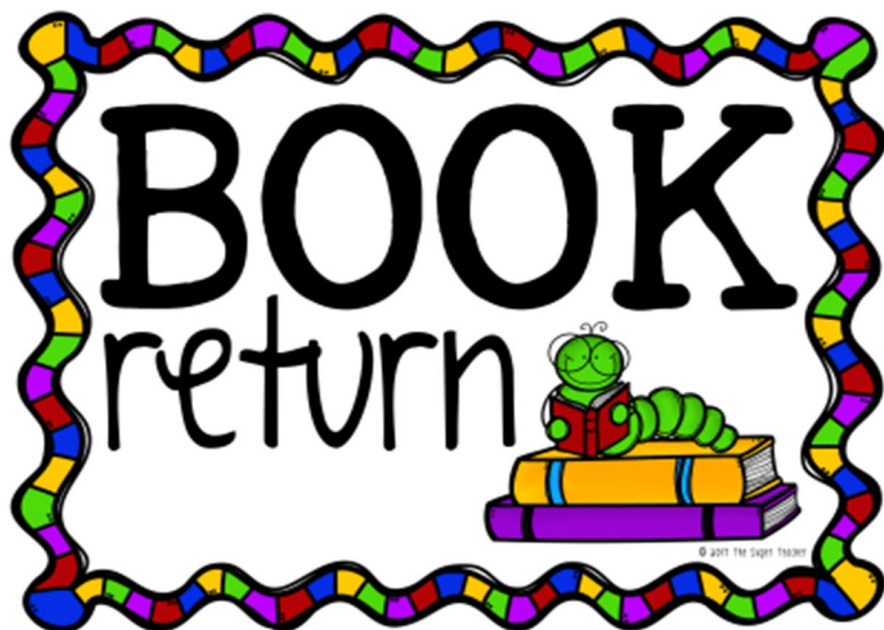

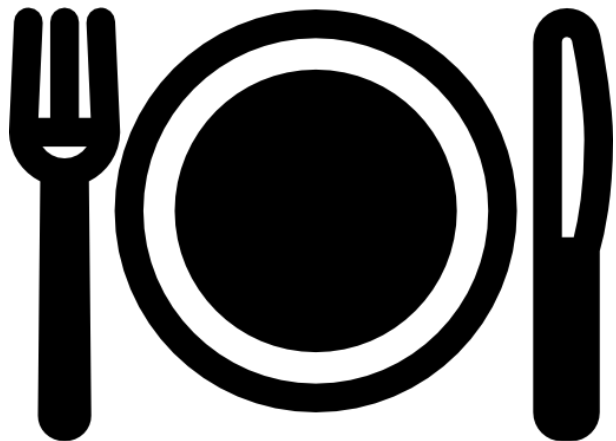
